- section 12 conditional offer of appointment/employment, adding upon conditional offer At the time of a conditional offer for a sworn Firefighter/Paramedic appointment, a candidate must possess a current Illinois EMT-Paramedic license and be certified as an Illinois OSFM Firefighter-Basic. The Board of Fire & Police Commissioners reserves the right to appoint a candidate who does not possess Firefighter-Basic on the subsequent pass through the eligibility list if the candidate otherwise meets the needs of the department.

Chief Stried request to begin the Firefighter testing process for hiring purposes.
